Our Philosophy

Grange Road Kindergarten provides a happy and relaxed environment where each child is valued as an individual. Our experienced approach to learning is through play. We value creativity highly. Our varied and balanced program respects each child – challenging and extending development in all areas. Each child, regardless of gender or ability, is encouraged to participate in all activities. Our aim is to prepare children for life’s challenges by emphasising the importance of communication, collaboration, optimism and conflict resolution skills.

We are very proud of our Grange Road Kindergarten team. Our caring staff members are a team of highly experienced, trained, and qualified early childhood professionals. They take their role in the development of our children very seriously and are passionate about what they do.

Group size is usually 22 children in each group. Staff Ratio is one staff member for 11 Children. **Proposed timetable for 2022 (subject to change, dependent on demand)**

Extended Care

Extended care is offered to all currently enrolled students at an additional cost. Preference will be given to those attending kinder that day, but if vacancies allow children can attend on another day. Extended care usually starts in Week 3 of term 1. Extended care will only run if there is sufficient demand.

Proposed Fees for 2022 (Subject to Change)

4yo fees based on 15 hours \$610 per term.

3yo fees based on 6 hours \$260 per term.

Plus \$100 non-refundable enrolment fee.

Plus \$150 Family Involvement Levy (refundable after completing two volunteer activities)

Extended Care Session: 3 hrs - \$320 per term. 3.5 hrs - \$440 per term.

Funded Kindergarten

Sessional Kindergarten in Victoria is partly funded by the Victorian State government. In 2022 Both 3 and 4yo kinder will receive funded. This funding is paid direct to the kindergarten and does not attract the Child Care Subsidy as paid to Long Day Care providers. Parent Involvement

Parents are asked to volunteer for kinder duty each term. These sessions are a lot of fun and it is a great way to get to know the teachers and the other children in your Kinder group. **We also have an active committee of management which will be voted in at our AGM in November 2021.** A parent involvement levy is charged in term one and refunded when two working bees or activities are completed. Our kinder has a child safe policy in place, and all volunteers should have a Working with Children Check.

The Kindergarten Community

We have a Social Committee, who organise many different activities such as group coffees/dinners, a welcome and farewell event each year, mothers and father's days, and a social/fundraising night for parents.

Policies

Grange Road Kindergarten reviews and updates its policies annually. Policies are compiled in a Policy Manual, a copy of which is available for reading in the foyer. Registration Process

Grange Road Kindergarten participates in the Central Registration scheme operated by Bayside City Council. **Registration must be completed online via Bayside City Council.** Places for the kindergarten program within the City of Bayside are allocated according to several criteria which are regularly reviewed.
